Fee Levy on DCC (Dynamic Currency Conversion) Transactions on IndusInd Bank Credit Card

With effect from 6th April 2023, a Dynamic Currency Conversion (DCC) Markup fee of 1% plus taxes will be applicable on all transactions carried out in Indian Currency at an international location or at merchants which are located in India but registered overseas.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What is Dynamic Currency Conversion?

Dynamic Currency Conversion is a point-of-sale or online payment option for international transactions which allows cardholders to pay in Indian Rupees at an international location or with a merchant located in India but registered overseas.

Example

If you use your Credit Card at a store in an international location and payment is made in domestic currency (INR) using your IndusInd Bank Credit Card on PoS machine, a DCC Markup fee of 1% + GST will be levied on the transaction amount. Similarly, if you make a purchase in India from a merchant registered outside India (overseas) and payment is made on your IndusInd Bank Credit Card in INR, a DCC Markup fee of 1% + GST will be levied on the transaction amount.
