<u>Sub: Intimation under Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listings Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('SEBI Listing Regulations') – Outcome of Board Meeting</u>

We wish to inform you that the Board of Directors of IndusInd Bank Limited ('the Bank') at its meeting held today, August 23, 2023, considered and approved the following matters:

1. Re-appointment of Director:

a) Re-appointment of Mr. Sanjay Asher, DIN: 00008221, as 'Non-Executive Independent Director' of the Bank, for a second term of four consecutive years, from October 10, 2023 up to October 9, 2027 (both days inclusive).

2. Re-appointment of M/s. Alwyn Jay & Co., Practicing Company Secretaries as a Secretarial Auditor of the Bank for Financial Year 2023-24 in compliance with provisions of Regulation 30, Schedule III, Part A, Para A (7) and other applicable provisions of the Listing Regulations.

The disclosures as required under Regulation 30 of the SEBI Listing Regulations read with SEBI Circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023, in connection with the appointment, are provided in 'Annexure C'.
