He sings a variety of songs related to local folklore as well as the sufi repertoire of Rajasthan. He also sings "Sufi Kalams" of famous sufi poets of the Sindh Area. The festival concludes with a performance on World Music, featuring a fusion performance by Sitar Maestro, Ustad Shujaat Husain Khan with George Brooks on Saxophone and Rez Abbasi on Guitar.

ICRA has also upgraded the Upper Tier II Bonds rating of IBL to LA+ rating with stable outlook from LA (pronounced L A) rating with stable outlook.
